Receipts: 302; Last Week: 272; Year Ago: 735

Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold uneven, from \$3 higher to \$4 lower on a very light test due to flooding. Slaughter cows sold \$1 higher and bulls sold steady; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 36 percent of the run, 64 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 40 percent of the offering, 47 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 31 percent.

625-675 lbs \$106-116.

FEEDER BULLS: Medium and Large 1-2: Pkg 575 lbs \$124.50; 625-700 lbs \$117.50-124.50.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, few \$75-79.75, High Dressing \$81.75-85.25, Low Dressing \$69; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$73-79.25, High Dressing \$81-84, Low Dressing \$65-69; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, few \$63-66, High Dressing \$71.50-72.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1110-1935 lbs, \$85.50-88.50, High Dressing \$90-91.

STOCKER COWS: Scarce.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 4-7 yrs old 1035-1245 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage \$1025-1340. 8 yr to short and solid mouth, 920-1160 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$700-800.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 4-6 yrs old, 1040-1220 lbs with 90-170 lbs calves, \$1325-1425 per pair.
