Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold steady to \$4 higher with better than average quality. Slaughter cows sold \$1 higher and bulls sold \$2 lower; Demand good and supply light. Cows made up approximately 12 percent of the run, 88 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 41 percent of the offering, 47 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 21 percent.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1450-1980 lbs, bulk \$55.75-59.50.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 8 yrs to short and solid mouth, 960-1285 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage \$500-590.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 1-2: 8 yrs to short and solid mouth, 890-1235 lbs with 60-150 lbs calves \$510-780 per pair. Δ
