Receipts: 405; Last Week: 585; Year Ago: 370

Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold \$2-5 higher on a light test. Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$2-3 higher; Demand good and supply light. Cows made up approximately 29 percent of the run, 71 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 42 percent of the offering, 50 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 21 percent.

112; 500-550 lbs \$101-107.50; few 600-675 lbs \$87.50-95.25. Large 1: Pkg 618 lbs \$86.75. Medium 2: Pkg 400 lbs \$91; 600-625 lbs \$85-96.

FEEDER BULLS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 600-700 lbs \$87.50-92.50; pkg 745 lbs \$80.25-85.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, few \$54-58.75, High Dressing \$59-60, Low Dressing \$47; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$46.75-56.50, High Dressing \$57-59, Low Dressing \$44.25; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, few \$39-45, High Dressing \$47, Low Dressing \$33.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1315-2145 lbs, bulk \$62-67, High Dressing \$68.50-70.25.

STOCKER COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Scarce.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: 3-6 yrs old, 880-1290 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage \$630-855.
