Receipts: 293; Last Week: 378; Year Ago: 362 Compared to last week, 300-350 lbs steers sold \$2-4 higher, the rest of the offering sold \$2-4 lower on a very light test. Slaughter cows sold \$1 higher and bulls sold steady; Demand ueven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 23 percent of the run, 77 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 37 percent of the offering, 49 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 25 percent.
