Receipts: 601; Last Week: 640; Year Ago: 461

Compared to last week, 300 lbs steers and heifers sold \$8 higher, the rest of the offering sold steady to \$5 lower. Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$1 lower; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 12 percent of the run, 88 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 36 percent of the offering, 48 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 31 percent.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1575-1945 lbs, bulk \$47.25-50, High Dressing \$51.50.

STOCKER COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 980-1075 lbs \$45-48.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: 5-7 yrs old, 880-1230 lbs 2nd and 3rd stage, \$660-840. Few 8 yrs to short and solid mouth, 860-1260 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$480-640.
