

# Fruitland Livestock Market

OCTOBER 7, 2010 • Fruitland, Mo.

Receipts: 438; Last Week: 421; Year Ago: 470

Compared to last week, steers sold \$1-5 higher, heifers sold steady to \$3 lower. Slaughter cows sold steady and bulls sold \$2 lower; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 23 percent of the run, 77 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 48 percent of the offering, 43 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 12 percent.

**FEEDER STEERS:** Medium and Large 1-2: Pkg 295 lbs \$116.50; 300-400 lbs \$109-116.75; 400-450 lbs \$112-120.50; 450-500 lbs \$107.50-113.50; 500-575 lbs \$101.25-109; pkg 700 lbs \$89; pkg 820 lbs \$92; pkg 954 lbs \$83.25. Medium 2: Few 450-475 lbs \$95-95.75; few 625-700 lbs \$84.50-92.50.

**FEEDER HOLSTEINS:** Large 3: Pkg 488 lbs \$83.50.

**FEEDER HEIFERS:** Medium and Large 1-2: Few 200-225 lbs \$123-125; few 300-375 lbs \$100-108; 400-500 lbs

\$92-99.50; few 500-575 lbs \$90.50-96.50; few 600-650 lbs \$87-91. Medium 2: Few 350-400 lbs \$86.50-93; 400-475 lbs \$80-91; few 500-600 lbs \$85-93.50.

**FEEDER BULLS:** Medium and Large 1-2: Few 550-575 lbs \$90-95; few 600-675 lbs \$90-92.50. Medium 2: Few 650-675 lbs \$76-87.

**SLAUGHTER COWS:** Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, few \$47-50, High Dressing \$52.25-55; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$46-50.25, High Dressing \$51.50-52, Low Dressing \$46.60; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, few \$40.50-44.25.

**SLAUGHTER BULLS:** Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1360-2250 lbs, bulk \$58.75-60.50, High Dressing \$62.50.

**STOCKER COWS:** Medium and Large 1-2: 3-5 yrs old, 985-1230 lbs; \$48-52.50.

**REPLACEMENT COWS:** Medium and Large 1-2: Few 5-7 yrs old, 970-1290 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$640-960.

**COW-CALF PAIRS:** Medium 2: 6-7 yrs old 890-1070 lbs with 80-140 lbs calves, \$840-875 per pair. Δ
