Receipts: 126; Last Week: 192; Year Ago: 465

Due to mud and snow the offering was too light for a trend comparison. Slaughter cows sold \$1 higher and bulls sold \$3 higher; Demand not tested and supply light. Cows made up approximately 26 percent of the run, 74 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 65 percent of the offering, 34 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 41 percent.

FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 400-450 lbs \$115; pkg 519 lbs \$109; few 625-650 lbs \$89.50-93. Medium 2: Pkg 375 lbs \$90; pkg 640 lbs \$84.75.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 500-600 lbs \$82.75-85.25; pkg 668 lbs \$82.50. Medium 2: Pkg

560 lbs \$77.50.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, Scarce; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$48.75-50.75, High Dressing few \$52-54.75, Low Dressing \$44.50; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, Scarce.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1655-1955 lbs, bulk \$58.50-63.75, High Dressing \$66.25.

STOCKER COWS: Scarce.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 5-7 yrs old, 970-1240 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$580-660. 8 yrs to short and solid mouth, 860-1190 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$400-525.
