Due to the Holidays there was no sale last week, however steers and heifers had instances of \$4-10 higher on a limited test. Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$5 higher; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 23 percent of the run, 77 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 60 percent of the offering 33 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 38 percent.
