Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold uneven, \$5 higher to \$2 lower, on a very limited test. Slaughter cows and bulls sold steady; Demand moderate and supply light. Cows made up approximately 35 percent of the run, 65 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 53 percent of the offering, 37 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 28 percent.
