Receipts: 730; Last Week: 254; Year Ago: 832

Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold \$5-10 higher. Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$3 higher; Demand good and supply light. Cows made up approximately 15 percent of the run, 85 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 46 percent of the offering, 51 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 37 percent.

FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 350-375 lbs \$119-129; 400-500 lbs \$115.50-128; 500-525 lbs \$111-120; 550-600 lbs \$105-112.50; 600-700 lbs \$98.50-107; 700-800 lbs \$88.50-100; few 800-875 lbs \$93.50-95.75. Medium 2: Few 350-400 lbs \$100-115; 450-500 lbs \$108-115; 500-575 lbs \$90-102.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 250-300 lbs \$121-136; 350-400 lbs \$111-125; 400-500 lbs \$102-116; 500-550 lbs \$97.50-105; 550-600 lbs \$90.50-95.25; 600-700 lbs \$88.50-95.75; 700-775 lbs \$80.25-94.25.

Medium 2: Few 350-400 lbs \$94-104; few 450-500 lbs \$99-102; few 525-550 lbs \$94.

FEEDER BULLS: Medium and Large 1-2: Pkg 532 lbs \$115; few 600-700 lbs \$93-95; 750-775 lbs \$81.50-86; pkg 840 lbs \$83.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, \$49.75-51, High Dressing \$56; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$48.25-52.75, High Dressing \$56.25-61.50, Low Dressing \$38; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, \$39.50-43.25, High Dressing \$47.50, Low Dressing \$33.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1215-2100 lbs \$56.25-62, High Dressing \$69.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Pot load of heifers, 1030-1220 lbs 3rd stage, \$975-1200. 4-7 yrs old, 890-1380 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage \$605-680.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 1-2: 8 yrs to short and solid mouth, 935-1270 lbs with 70-170 lbs calves, \$620-825 per pair. Δ
