Compared to last week, 300-400 lbs and 700 lbs steers and the heifer offering sold \$1-3 higher, the rest of the steer offering sold \$3 lower. Slaughter cows sold \$1 lower and bulls sold \$2 higher; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 17 percent of the run, 83 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 41 percent of the offering, 52 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 34 percent.
