Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold steady to \$3 higher on a very light test. Very hot this week again and not many cattle are moving. In the cow offering there was a 100 head of Reg. Angus from a complete sell out. Slaughter cows sold \$2 higher and bulls sold \$1 higher; Demand moderate and supply very light. Cows made up approximately 38 percent of the run, 62 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 35 percent of the offering, 45 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 30 percent.
