Receipts: 428; Last Week: 182; Year Ago: 126

Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold \$4 higher on a limited test. Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$1 higher; Demand good and supply light. Cows made up approximately 46 percent of the run, 64 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 45 percent of the offering, 47 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 25 percent.

STOCKER COWS: Scarce.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: 2 yrs old 1040-1230 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage \$1050-1400. Medium 2: 2-8 yrs old, 835-1040 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$760-950.

COW-CALF PAIRS: 2-6 yrs old, 1020-1200 lbs with 120-200 lbs calves, \$1100-1700 per pair. Δ
