Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold \$5-10 lower due to the unstable economy. Slaughter cows sold \$1 higher and bulls sold \$2 lower; Demand very light and supply light. Cows made up approximately 21 percent of the run, 79 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 29 percent of the offering, 62 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 27 percent.
