Compared to last week, steers sold \$1-3 lower, heifers sold uneven, \$2 higher to \$2 lower in a light test, overall quality was lower than past week. Slaughter cows sold \$2 lower and bulls sold \$2 higher; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 31 percent of the run, 69 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 41 percent of the offering, 54 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 17 percent.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, few \$53-57.25, High Dressing \$60.25-62; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$50.50-56, High Dressing \$58.25-60.25; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, Scarce.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1165-1960 lbs, bulk \$65-68.75, High Dressing \$70.75-72.

STOCKER COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: 865-1185 lbs \$60-69.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 4-7 yrs old, 915-1230 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$700-730.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium 2: Few 4-6 yrs old, 985-1260 lbs with 100-170 lbs calves, \$910-1020 per pair. Δ
