Receipts: 241; Last Week: 388; Year Ago: 567

Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold uneven, \$2 higher to \$2 lower in a very light test. Very hot this week and not many cattle are moving and not many want to be moved. Slaughter cows sold steady and bulls sold \$1 lower; Demand uneven and supply very light. Cows made up approximately 15 percent of the run, 85 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 40 percent of the offering, 50 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 12 percent.

FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Pkg 275 lbs \$126-130; few 300-325 lbs \$135-140; few 400-425 lbs \$115-125; few 450-500 lbs \$111.50-120; few 500-575 lbs \$110.50-115; few 600-650 lbs \$100-110. Medium 2: Pkg 250 lbs \$119; pkg 370 lbs \$122; few 450-475 lbs \$101-107.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 200-250 lbs \$122-128; few 300-400 lbs \$118-126; few 400-450 lbs \$109-116; few 450-500 lbs \$100-110.25; few 500-525 lbs \$101-109.50; pkg 722 lbs \$92. Medium 2: Pkg 335 lbs \$115-117.50; few 600-675 lbs \$87.50-95.

FEEDER BULLS: Medium 2: Few 525-600 lbs \$90-100.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, few \$52-57; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$48.50-56.50, High Dressing \$59-60.50; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, Scarce.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1285-1920 lbs, bulk \$63-67.50.

STOCKER COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Scarce.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Scarce.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium 2: Few 3-5 yrs old, 990-1270 lbs with 110-190 lb calves, \$950-1010 per pair. Δ
