Receipts: 582; Last Week: 983; Year Ago: 355

Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold uneven \$2 higher to \$4 lower. Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$4-5 higher; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 18 percent of the run, 82 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 47 percent of the offering, 43 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 24 percent.

FEEDER HOLSTEINS: Large 3: Pkg 356 lbs \$75.50; pkg 625 lbs \$72.50.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1-2: 250-300 lbs \$110-116; 300-400 lbs \$99-109; 400-450 lbs \$99-106; 500-

600 lbs \$90.50-98.50; 600-700 lbs \$85-95.50; pkg 745 lbs \$85. Medium 2: Pkg 262 lbs \$100; few 300-325 lbs \$92.50-98; 400-475 lbs \$89-99.50; 525-550 lbs \$84.50-85.50; few 600-650 lbs \$82-82.50; pkg 850 lbs \$75.

FEEDER BULLS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 550-575 lbs \$95-100; 600-650 lbs \$87-94.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, few \$48-52, High Dressing \$54; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$48-53, High Dressing few \$56.50-57.50, Low Dressing \$45; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, \$42-46, High Dressing few \$49.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1220-1890 lbs, bulk \$60-65, High Dressing \$70.50-73.50.

STOCKER COWS: Scarce.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: 4-7 yrs old, 980-1430 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$660-950.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 8 yrs to short and solid mouth, 950-1260 lbs with 90-130 lbs calves, \$580-650. Δ
