Compared to last week, 500 lbs steers sold \$3 higher, the rest of the offering sold uneven \$1-6 lower. Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$1 lower; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 23 percent of the run, 77 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 32 percent of the offering, 48 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 30 percent.
