Receipts: 624; Last Week: 656; Year Ago: 643

Compared to last week, steers over 600 lbs and the heifers offering sold \$3-5 higher, the rest of the steer offering sold steady. Slaughter cows sold steady and bulls sold \$1 lower; Demand good and supply light. Cows made up approximately 23 percent of the run, 77 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 51 percent of the offering, 37 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 25 percent.

Medium 2: Pkg 290 lbs \$126; few 300-325 lbs \$112-115; few 400-500 lbs \$115-121; pkg 552 lbs \$116.50; pkg 615 lbs \$110.

FEEDER HOLSTEINS: Large 3: Pkg 358 lbs \$90; few 400-500 lbs \$95; pkg 518 lbs \$90; pkg 750 lbs \$82.75.

\$129; few 300-400 lbs \$120-125; 400-500 lbs \$117.50-127; 500-600 lbs \$114.50-125; 625-675 lbs \$114-122.50. Medium 2: Pkg 370 lbs \$112; few 450-500 lbs \$113.50-115.50; few 500-550 lbs \$107.50-115.50; few 600-650 lbs \$100-108; pkg 750 lbs \$90.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, few \$58-67.50, High Dressing \$70-71.50; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$57-66.75, High Dressing \$70-72, Low Dressing \$53.50-60.75; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, few \$48.50-54, High Dressing \$59.50, Low Dressing \$40.50-43.50.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1490-2180 lbs bulk \$70-75.50.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium 2: Few 4-6 yrs 845-980 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$800-900. Short and solid mouth, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$610-710. Δ
