Compared to last week, steers and helfers sold uneven, \$3 higher to \$4 lower. Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$1 higher; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 24 percent of the run, 76 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 37 percent of the offering, 58 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 13 percent.
