Slaughter cows and bulls sold steady to \$1 higher; Demand supply light. Cows made up approximately 17 percent of the run, 83 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 42 percent of the offering, 40 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 14 percent.
