Compared to last week steers and heifers sold uneven. Most trended \$3-8 lower, 500-600 lb males \$10 higher. Slaughter bulls and cows sold steady.

FEEDER STEERS: 200-300 lbs \$170-180; 300-400 lbs \$152-175; 400-500 lbs \$146-163; 500-600 lbs \$139-150.50; 600-700 lbs \$125-137; 700-800 lbs \$104-120; 800-1000 lbs \$100-115.

FEEDER HEIFERS: 200-300 lbs \$170-180; 300-400 lbs \$142-156; 400-500 lbs \$134-147; 500-600 lbs \$122-133; 600-700 lbs \$113-120; 700-800 lbs \$107-111; 800-1000 lbs \$93-104.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean,

\$70-75, High Dressing \$76-82, Low Dressing \$65-70; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$68-73, High Dressing \$74-82, Low Dressing \$62-67; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, \$65-69, High Dressing \$75-83, Low Dressing \$55-62.

BABY CALVES: Brown \$55; Holstein \$50-100; Beef \$210.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: High Yield \$95-105; Low Yield \$75-85.

BRED COWS: 5 yr old to short solid 1250-1350 lbs 2nd stage \$1350-1450. Old cows 2nd and 3rd stage 1000-1300 lbs \$900-1050.

COW-CALF PAIRS: 6 yr old cows with 250 lbs calves \$1650. Broken mouth to short solid cows with small calves \$1225-1350. Δ
