Extreme drought, very spotty rain, and general prospects for crop conditions not good are driving the market lower. Quality and condition of many animals are deteriorating. Of the offering over 1/2 were cows. Feeder cattle coming to market are weighing lighter \$5-10 higher. We are still seeing high numbers of cows hitting the market. Steady.

BRED COWS : 2-7 yrs old 1050-1300 lbs 2nd & 3rd stage \$800-1000.
COW-CALF PAIRS: 4 yr old cows with 100-200 lb calf \$1275-1425; 7 yr old-ss cows with 100-200 lb calf \$1035-1150.
