Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold \$6-12 higher with good quality in the offering. Slaughter cows sold \$3 lower and bulls sold \$1 lower; Demand very good and supply light. Cows made up approximately 28 percent of the run, 72 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 40 percent of the offering, 49 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 22 percent.
