Compared to last week, steers and heifers over 500 lbs sold steady to \$2 higher, the light offering under 500 lbs sold \$4-6 lower on a light test. Slaughter cows sold \$2 higher and bulls not tested; demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 24 percent of the run, 76 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 36 percent of the offering, 55 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 30 percent.
