Receipts: 469; Last Week: 375; Year Ago: 767

Compared to last week, 400 lbs steers sold \$4 lower, the rest of the feeder offering sold steady to \$4 higher. Slaughter cows sold \$3 higher and bulls \$2 higher; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 24 percent of the run, 76 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 41 percent of the offering, 43 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 16 percent.

FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 250-300 lbs \$108-117; few 300-350 lbs \$107-120; 350-400 lbs \$105-113; 400-450 lbs \$100-108; 450-500 lbs \$95-104.50; 500-575 lbs \$92.50-99.50; 600-650 lbs \$88-90. Medium 2: Few 300-350 lbs \$104-105; few 400-500 lbs \$84-97; few 500-550 lbs \$84-91; pkg 600 lbs \$80.

FEEDER HOLSTEINS: Large 3: Pkg 298 lbs \$69; pkg 493 lbs \$62; few 500-550 lbs \$60-61; pkg 618 lbs \$62; pkg 758 lbs \$55; pkg 817 lbs \$52.50.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 200-

250 lbs \$114-120; few 250-300 lbs \$102-113; few 300-400 lbs \$94.50-102; 400-500 lbs \$87.75-97.75; 500-600 lbs \$78.50-87.25; few 600-650 lbs \$80.25-84.50; few 700-750 lbs \$70.25-76; pkg 941 lbs \$65.25. Medium 2: Pkg 260 lbs \$93; 300-400 lbs \$80-90; few 450-500 lbs \$78-84; few 500-600 lbs \$75.25-78.50.

FEEDER BULLS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 500-550 lbs \$80.25-87.75; few 600-675 lbs \$75.75-80.75; pkg 705 lbs \$70.25.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, few \$39-42, High Dressing \$46; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$38.50-44.50, High Dressing \$47-50, Low Dressing one at \$54; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, few \$33-36.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: 1325-1945 lbs bulk \$49-55.75, High Dressing \$56.75.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 3-7 yrs old, 980-1355 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage \$620-670.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 4-7 yrs old, 965-1390 lbs with 70-160 lbs calves \$725-970 per pair. Δ
