Compared to last week, 500 lbs heifers sold steady, the rest of the offering sold \$3-6 lower. Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$1 lower; Demand and supply light. Cows made up approximately 23 percent of the run, 77 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 44 percent of the offering, 46 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 28 percent.

FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 300-350 lbs \$106-115; few 350-400 lbs \$99-107; 425-450 lbs \$94-101; 450-500 lbs \$86.50-95; 500-600 lbs \$88.50-99.50; 600-675 lbs \$84.25-89; 750-775 lbs \$87.50-93. Medium 2: Pkg 394 lbs \$95.50; 400-500 lbs \$83.50-88.50; few 525-550 lbs \$82.50-86; pkg 620 lbs \$75.

FEEDER HOLSTEINS: Large 3: Few 500-575 lbs \$58.75-64.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1-2: 300-350 lbs

\$88.50-96; 350-400 lbs \$84.75-91; 400-500 lbs \$80-89; 500-600 lbs \$78.50-87.25; few 600-675 lbs \$78-84; 725-800 lbs \$80.25-89.50. Medium 2: Few 325-400 lbs \$78-84; few 500-575 lbs \$73.50-75; pkg 628 lbs \$70.25.

FEEDER BULLS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 500-575 lbs \$75.50-84; few 600-625 lbs \$77-81.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, few \$45-46.50; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$46.75-48, High Dressing \$50-52.75, Low Dressing \$43; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, Scarce.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: 1775-2025 lbs \$54.75-59.50.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 3-7 yrs old, 880-1415 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$710-940.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 2-6 yrs old, 840-1260 lbs, with 70-130 lbs calves, \$930-1000 per pair.
