Receipts: 523; Last Week: 275; Year Ago: 352

Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold steady to \$3 higher. Slaughter cows sold \$1 higher and bulls sold steady; Demand moderate and supply light. Cows made up approximately 19 percent of the run, 81 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 51 percent of the offering, 40 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 37 percent.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, few \$45-47.25, High Dressing \$50; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$45-49, High Dressing \$51-52.75, Low Dressing \$42.25; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, \$35.50-37.75.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: 1525-2290 lbs \$56-60.25.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: few 6-7 yrs old, 940-1245 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$660-770.
