Receipts: 457; Last Week: 493; Year Ago: 722

Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold \$2-10 higher. Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$1-2 higher; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 22 percent of the run, 78 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 51 percent of the offering, 44 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 20 percent.

FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Pkg 205 lbs \$210; few 250-300 lbs \$165-176; 300-350 lbs \$173-190; 400-500 lbs \$150-164.50; 500-600 lbs \$135-146; pkg 606 lbs \$133.50; few 700-750 lbs \$130-135.50; few 850-900 lbs \$115-120. Medium 2: Few 350-400 lbs \$138-146; few 400-450 lbs \$141-149.50; few 450-500 lbs \$131-143; few 500-575 lbs \$121-133; few 600-675 lbs \$115-128.

FEEDER HOLSTEINS: Large 3: Pkg 331 lbs \$99.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 300-400

lbs \$131-141; 400-500 lbs \$128-140; few 500-550 lbs \$129-133; 550-600 lbs \$119-128; few 600-700 lbs \$116-127; pkg 738 lbs \$127.50. Medium 2: Pkg 260 lbs \$132.50; few 475-500 lbs \$120-125; 500-550 lbs \$120-126; pkg 908 lbs \$95.

FEEDER BULLS: Medium and Large 1-2: Pkg 525 lbs \$135; few 600-700 lbs \$121-126.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, \$59.50-63, High Dressing \$65.75-69.25; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$58-63, High Dressing \$65.75-70.50, Low Dressing \$56.50; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, Scarce.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1620-2360 lbs Bulk \$68.75-74.25, High Dressing \$76.75-81.

STOCKER COWS: Medium and Large 2: Scarce.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 3-6 yrs old, 880-1215 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$860-1025.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 4-5 yrs old, 935-1210 lbs with 90-120 lbs calves, \$930-1080 per pair. Δ
