FEEDER STEERS: 200-300 lbs \$115-175; 300-400 lbs \$152-170; 400-500 lbs \$145-164.50; 500-600 lbs \$140-150.50; 600-700 lbs \$130-140; 700-800 lbs \$110-130; 800-1000 lbs \$94-117.

HOLSTEIN STEERS: 200-300 lbs \$118; 400-500 lbs \$95.

FEEDER HEIFERS: 200-300 lbs \$155-162.50; 300-400 lbs \$146-160; 400-500 lbs \$135-150; 500-600 lbs \$127-136; 600-700 lbs \$125-134; 700-800 lbs \$100-110.

BABY CALVES: Brown \$45; Holstein \$140-175; Beef \$270-310 (good quality high demand).

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, \$70-75, High Dressing \$76-82, Low Dressing \$65-70; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, 68-73, High Dressing \$74-84.50, Low Dressing \$62-67; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, \$65-69, High Dressing \$70-74, Low Dressig \$55-62.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: High Yield \$95-102.50; Low Yield \$75-85.

BRED COWS: 2-5 yr old cows 850-900 lbs 2nd-3rd stage \$900-1200. 4-6 yr old cows 900-1100 lbs 2nd-3rd stage \$900-1225.

COW-CALF PAIRS: 4-6 yr cows with 300 lb calves \$1250. Short solid cows with 250 lb calves \$1325.
