Receipts: 370; Last Week: 567; Year Ago: 416

Compared to last week, 300-400 lbs offering sold steady to \$2 higher, the rest of the offering sold \$1-3 lower. Slaughter cows sold \$1 lower and bulls sold \$2 lower; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 27 percent of the run, 63 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 41 percent of the offering, 48 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 21 percent.

FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 250-300 lbs \$112-125; few 300-350 lbs \$111-117; few 450-500 lbs \$100.50-106.25; few 500-600 lbs \$97-104; few 600-650 lbs \$90-95; few 700-750 lbs \$87.25-89.25; few 825-850 lbs \$85.25-86.25. Medium 2: Pkg 263 lbs \$96; pkg 375 lbs \$107; few 450-500 lbs \$95-95.50; few 550-600 lbs \$90-94.50.

FEEDER HOLSTEINS: Large 3: Pkg 581 lbs \$57.75.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1-2: 350-400 lbs \$94.50-102; 400-500 lbs \$90-103; few 500-600 lbs \$84.25-

92.50; few 600-675 lbs \$81.75-88.75. Medium 2: Pkg 420 lbs \$82; few 500-600 lbs \$80-85.50.

FEEDER BULLS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 550-600 lbs \$96-102. Medium 2: Pkg 500 lbs \$86; pkg 628 lbs \$77.75.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, few \$44-48, High Dressing \$50.25; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$44-47, High Dressing \$49, Low Dressing \$42.50; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, few \$35-39.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: 1370-2040 lbs, bulk \$52.75-55.50, High Dressing \$58.25.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: 2-8 yrs old, 880-1320 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$720-950. 8 yrs to short and solid mouth, 790-1310 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$530-720.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 1-2: 4-7 yrs old, 940-1440 lbs, with 75-250 lbs calves, \$900-1050 per pair. 8 yrs to short and solid mouth, 900-1410 lbs with 90-260 lbs calves, \$650-860 per pair. Δ
