Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$2 higher; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 21 percent of the run, 79 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 43 percent of the offering, 43 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 14 percent.
