**Receipts: 355; Last Week: 211; Year Ago: 501**

Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold uneven, \$1 lower to \$4 higher Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$1-2 higher; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 46 percent of the run, 54 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 44 percent of the offering 48 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 6 percent.

**FEEDER STEERS:** Medium and Large 1-2: Few 200-225 lbs \$121-131; 300-400 lbs \$105-113.50; 400-500 lbs \$103-111; 500-525 lbs \$99-109; pkg 605 lbs \$107.25. Medium 2: Few 300-325 lbs \$95-100.50; 425-500 lbs \$90-101.50.

**FEEDER HEIFERS:** Medium and Large 1-2: Few 250-275 lbs \$104.50-110; 300-400 lbs \$95-108.50; 400-500 lbs \$95-103; 550-600 lbs \$90-100; 600-700 lbs \$90-93.25.

Medium 2: Pkg 360 lbs \$94; few 400-450 lbs \$87-92; pkg 530 lbs \$84.

**FEEDER BULLS:** Medium and Large 1-2: 525-600 lbs \$85.50-98.75.

**SLAUGHTER COWS:** Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, \$55-61, High Dressing \$63.50-67; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$56.50-61.50, High Dressing \$64.25-67, Low Dressing \$48.25; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, \$45.50-49.50.

**SLAUGHTER BULLS:** Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1340-2125 lbs, \$68.75-73, High Dressing \$75.50-77.

**REPLACEMENT COWS:** Medium and Large 1-2: 3-7 yrs old, 995-1340 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$730-950. 8 yrs old to short and solid mouth, 970-1320 lbs 2nd and 3rd stage, \$525-710.

**COW-CALF PAIRS:** Medium and Large 1-2, Few 5-7 yrs old, 1125-1345 lbs with 80-150 lbs calves, \$1025-1040 per pair. Δ
