Receipts: 401; Last Week: 735; Year Ago: 835

Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold steady to \$4 lower. Slaughter cows and bulls sold steady; Demand and supply light. Cows made up approximately 27 percent of the run, 73 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 40 percent of the offering, 50 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 31 percent.

FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 300-400 lbs \$121-133; 400-500 lbs \$122-134; 500-600 lbs \$115.25-126.50; few 600-700 lbs \$100-111. Medium 2: Few 450-500 lbs \$112-112.50; few 625-650 lbs \$94-103.

FEEDER HOLSTEINS: Large 3: Few 325-350 lbs \$85-89; pkg 472 lbs \$82.50; pkg 652 lbs \$67; pkg 748 lbs \$75.50.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 250-300 lbs \$121-126; few 300-400 lbs \$114.50-124; 400-500 lbs \$110.50-120; 500-600 lbs \$106-117; 600-700 lbs \$100-109; few 700-750 lbs \$102-103; few 825-850 lbs \$85-91. Medium 2: Few 525-575 lbs \$98-105.50.

FEEDER BULLS: Medium and Large 1-2: Pkg 590 lbs \$95.50; pkg 925 lbs \$80.50.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, few \$54.50-61.50, High Dressing \$63.50-64.75; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$56.50-61, High Dressing \$63.50-65.25, Low Dressing \$53; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, few \$45-53.50, High Dressing \$56.50.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1445-2320 lbs, bulk \$64-69, High Dressing \$73.25-75.75, Low Dressing \$58.50.

STOCKER COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 820-1150 lbs, \$58.25-70.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: 3-7 yrs old, 920-1310 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$800-1005. 8 yrs to short and solid mouth, 840-1245 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$610-780.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 4-8 yrs old, 880-1375 lbs with 80-160 lb calves, \$810-1000 per pair.
