Receipts: 656; Last Week: 340; Year Ago: 530

Compared to last week, 500-600 lbs heifers sold \$3 higher, the rest of the offering sold \$2-3 lower. Slaughter cows sold steady and bulls sold \$1 higher; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 29 percent of the run, 71 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 26 percent of the offering, 46 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 19 percent.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, few \$58.50-66, High Dressing \$69.50-74, Low Dressing \$60; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$58-66.50, High Dressing \$69.75-71.50, Low Dressing \$53.50-60.75; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, few \$50.25-55.50, High Dressing \$60.75, Low Dressing \$40.50-43.50.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1465-1965 lbs bulk \$71.25-76, High Dressing \$79.75-82, Low Dressing \$66.75.

STOCKER COWS : Scarce.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium 2: Few 4-6 yrs, 780-970 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage \$625-970.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Scarce.
