The offering was too small for a trend comparison, however there were undertones of \$1-3 higher. Slaughter cows sold \$1 lower and bulls scarce; Demand moderate and supply light. Cows made up approximately 23 percent of the run, 77 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 39 percent of the offering, 52 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 26 percent.
