There was too small of an offering for a trend comparison, however undertone lower. Slaughter cows and bulls sold steady; Demand and supply light. Cows made up approximately 26 percent of the run, 74 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 64 percent of the offering, 30 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 14 percent.

FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1-2: 250-300 lbs \$105-118; 400-450 lbs \$103-112; 500-600 lbs \$100-110; 600-675 lbs \$98-100. Medium 2: 400-500 lbs \$90.50-96; few 550-600 lbs \$90.50-92.50.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Pkg 337 lbs

\$100; 400-475 lbs \$95.50-103.50; 500-550 lbs \$94.50-96.50; 600-625 lbs \$90.25-95.50.

FEEDER BULLS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 600-650 lbs \$87-90.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, Scarce; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$56.50-60.50, High Dressing \$61.50-65, Low Dressing \$48.25; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, Scarce.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1640-2195 lbs \$65.75-71, High Dressing \$72.50.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 4-7 yrs old, 1085-1260 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$640-730.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 4-7 yrs old 955-1235 lbs with 90-190 lbs calves \$870-970 per pair.
