

# Fruitland Livestock Market

**Receipts: 635; Last Week: 582; Year Ago: 509**

Compared to last week, 600 lbs steers sold steady, the rest of the offering sold \$3-8 higher. Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$1 higher; Demand good and supply light. Cows made up approximately 16 percent of the run, 84 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 45 percent of the offering, 53 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 18 percent.

**FEEDER STEERS:** Medium and Large 1-2: Few 250-300 lbs \$121-132.50; 350-400 lbs \$113-123.50; 400-450 lbs \$115-126.50; 450-500 lbs \$111-122; 500-600 lbs \$110-121; 600-700 lbs \$100-104.50; few 700-800 lbs \$97-99; few 900-950 lbs \$80.25. Medium 2: Few 300-400 lbs \$100.50-110.50; pkg 400-500 lbs \$100-110.50; few 500-550 lbs \$100-107; pkg 680 lbs \$94.

**FEEDER HOLSTEINS:** Large 3: Pkg 375 lbs \$75.50.

**FEEDER HEIFERS:** Medium and Large 1-2: 250-300 lbs \$110-120; 300-350 lbs \$112-116; 350-400 lbs \$103-114; 400-500 lbs \$100-110.75; 500-600 lbs \$97-107; 600-675 lbs \$85.25-96.50; pkg 785 lbs \$82.50; few 800-850 lbs \$78-80.

Medium 2: Pkg 290 lbs \$94; few 300-400 lbs \$92-104; few 400-500 lbs \$90.50-100.50; 500-600 lbs \$87-95.50; pkg 775 lbs \$77.

**FEEDER BULLS:** Medium and Large 1-2: Pkg 565 lbs \$100.

**SLAUGHTER COWS:** Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, few \$48-53.25, High Dressing \$58; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$48-55, High Dressing few \$58.50-61.50, Low Dressing \$45; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, \$44-46, High Dressing few \$47.50, Low Dressing \$30.

**SLAUGHTER BULLS:** Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1375-2330 lbs, bulk \$60-66, High Drssing \$68.50-71.

**STOCKER COWS:** Scarce.

**REPLACEMENT COWS:** Medium and Large 1-2: 4-7 yrs old, 870-1310 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$720-850. 8 yrs to short and solid mouth, 920-1290 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$550-690.

**COW-CALF PAIRS:** Medium and Large 1-2: 4-7 yrs old, 935-1335 lbs with 70-110 lb calves, \$730-975 per pair. Few 8 yrs to short and solid mouth, 910-1230 lbs with 80-120 lbs calves, \$500-680 per pair. Δ
