Compared to last week, 600 lbs heifers sold \$5 higher, the rest of the offering sold \$4-5 lower. Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$1 lower; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 26 percent of the run, 74 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 41 percent of the offering, 53 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 20 percent.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1430-2050 lbs, Bulk \$80.50-88.50.

STOCKER COWS: Scarce.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 3-5 yrs old 985-1245 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage \$990-1325. 8 yr to short and solid mouth, 1010-1125 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$730-900.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 5-8 yrs old, 1030-1360 lbs, with 70-230 lbs calves, \$960-1425 per pair. Δ
