Compared to last week, steers over 400 lbs sold steady to \$4 higher, the rest of the feeder offering sold \$2-4 lower. Slaughter cows sold \$2 lower and bulls scarce; Demand uneven and suppy light. Cows made up approximately 20 percent of the run 80 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 61 percent of the offering, 27 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 46 percent.
