

# Fruitland Livestock Market

There will be no sale at Fruitland (May 26; June 30; July 28)

Compared to last week, steers sold \$1-5 lower, heifers sold uneven, \$2 higher to \$2 lower. Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$1 lower; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 21 percent of the run, 79 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 47 percent of the offering, 49 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 17 percent.

**FEEDER STEERS:** Medium and Large 1-2: Few 275-300 lbs \$118-130; few 300-400 lbs \$108-118.50; 400-500 lbs \$106-116; 500-600 lbs \$99-109; 600-650 lbs \$93-96; 750-775 lbs \$85.50-89.50. Medium 2: Pkg 345 lbs \$107; few 400-450 lbs \$85-92; 550-600 lbs \$87-89.50; pkg 707 lbs \$85.50.

**FEEDER HOLSTEINS:** Large 3: Pkg 150 lbs \$83; pkg 358 lbs \$67.50.

**FEEDER HEIFERS:** Medium and Large 1-2: Few 275-300 lbs \$110-120; 300-350 lbs \$106-117; 350-400 lbs \$98-

108; 400-450 lbs \$97-105; 450-500 lbs \$86-98; 500-575 lbs \$85-96.50; 600-675 lbs \$80.25-89; few 725-750 lbs \$80.25. Medium 2: Few 325-400 lbs \$84-96; 400-500 lbs \$85-95.50; few 500-550 lbs \$82.50-86.50.

**FEEDER BULLS:** Medium and Large 1-2: Pkg 790 lbs \$82.50.

**SLAUGHTER COWS:** Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, few \$47-51.25, High Dressing \$52.75-55, Low Dressing \$43; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$45.75-50.50, High Dressing \$51.50, Low Dressing \$42.25; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, few \$34.50-39.

**SLAUGHTER BULLS:** Yield Grade 1-2: 1475-2145 lbs, bulk \$55-58.50, High Dressing \$61-62.75, Low Dressing \$50.

**REPLACEMENT COWS:** Medium and Large 1-2: Few 4-7 yrs old, 880-1290 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage \$650-830. 8 short and solid mouth, 870-1340 lbs 2nd and 3rd stage, \$480-530.

**COW-CALF PAIRS:** Medium and Large 1-2: Few 5-7 yrs old, 920-1340 lbs with 80-170 lbs calves, \$850-920 per pair.
