Receipts: 428; Last Week: 478; Year Ago: 640

Compared to last week, 400 lbs steers sold \$5 lower, the rest of the offering sold steady to \$5 higher. Slaughter cows sold steady and bulls sold \$1 higher; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 19 percent of the run, 89 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 39 percent of the offering, 51 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 34 percent.

FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 350-400 lbs \$110-117; 400-500 lbs \$101.50-111; 500-575 lbs \$97.50-105; few 600-700 lbs \$99-104.75; few 700-800 lbs \$93.25-102. Medium 2: Few 300-400 lbs \$104-108.50; 400-500 lbs \$93.50-105.25; pkg 590 lbs \$94.50; few 600-650 lbs \$87.25-92.50.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 250-300 lbs \$107-108; few 300-400 lbs \$103-107.50; 400-500 lbs \$93.50-105.25; 500-600 lbs \$92.75-100; 625-700 lbs \$92-100; few 800-850 lbs \$81-83.50. Medium 2: Pkg 455

lbs \$88.50; few 500-600 lbs \$80.50-88; 625-700 lbs \$82.50-88.

FEEDER BULLS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 550-600 lbs \$92.75-99; few 600-625 lbs \$93-97.50; 700-750 lbs \$86-88.50.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, few \$46-51.75, High Dressing \$53-54.50; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$46.50-50.25, High Dressing \$52.50, Low Dressing \$44; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, few \$36.50-42, High Dressing \$47.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1445-2095 lbs, bulk \$59.75-61.25, High Dressing \$62.25.

STOCKER COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Scarce.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 5-7 yrs old, 1080-1275 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$625-730.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 5-7 yrs old, 1020-1325 lbs with 90-180 lbs calves, \$865-925 per pair. Δ
