Too small of an offering to form a trend. Slaughter cows and bulls sold steady; Supply very light. Cows made up approximately 19 percent of the run, 81 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 58 percent of the offering, 32 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 30 percent.

350 lbs \$103.50-116; 450-500 lbs \$92-103; 500-600 lbs \$84-93; pkg 690 lbs \$84.75; pkg 750 lbs \$80.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, \$45.50-48, High Dressing \$54.50; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$45-49.75, High Dressing \$51.75-53.25, Low Dressing \$38; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, \$34.25-36.50, High Dressing \$41, Low Dressing \$25.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1415-2335 lbs \$54-58, High Dressing \$61.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: 3-7 yrs old, 930-1350 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$660-730. 8 yrs-short and solid mouth, 850-1250 lbs 2nd and 3rd stage, \$460-550.
