

# Fruitland Livestock Market

Receipts: 381; Last Week: 521; Year Ago: 438

Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold steady to \$3 higher, on a light test. Slaughter cows and bulls sold steady; Demand moderate and supply light. Cows made up approximately 31 percent of the run, 69 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 43 percent of the offering, 40 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 11 percent.

**FEEDER STEERS:** Medium and Large 1-2: Few 275-300 lbs \$134-142.50; few 300-400 lbs \$131-146; few 400-500 lbs \$123-135.50; 500-550 lbs \$125.50-133; 600-650 lbs \$122-125.50. Medium 2: Few 300-400 lbs \$120-129; few 425-500 lbs \$120-126.50; pkg 660 lbs \$105.

**FEEDER HOLSTEINS:** Large 3: Pkg 459 lbs \$101.50; pkg 601 lbs \$92.25.

**FEEDER HEIFERS:** Medium and Large 1-2: Few 250-300 lbs \$131-134; 300-400 lbs \$121-133; 450-500 lbs \$123-131; few 500-575 lbs \$115-127; few 625-650 lbs

\$114.50-124; pkg 710 lbs \$105.50. Medium 2: Pkg 388 lbs \$117.50; few 400-500 lbs \$113-121; pkg 762 lbs \$95.50.

**FEEDER BULLS:** Medium and Large 1-2: Few 500-600 lbs \$115.50-126.50; pkg 600 lbs \$110. Medium 2: Few 550-575 lbs \$107.50-116.

**SLAUGHTER COWS:** Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, few \$56.25-61.25, High Dressing \$63.25-66; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$55.25-60, High Dressing \$61.25-64.50, Low Dressing \$51.50; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, few \$46.50-49.50, High Dressing \$52, Low Dressing \$37.50-39.

**SLAUGHTER BULLS:** Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1415-2150 lbs bulk \$70-71.50, High Dressing \$72.25-73.25.

**STOCKER COWS:** Medium and Large 2: Scarce.

**REPLACEMENT COWS:** Medium and Large 1-2: Few 3-7 yrs, 905-1295 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$690-830.

**COW-CALF PAIRS:** Medium and Large 1-2: Few 4-7 yrs old, 985-1215 lbs with 110-240 lbs calves, \$900-1100 per pair. Δ
