Receipts: 775; Last Week: 465; Year Ago: 730

Compared to last week, the 300 lbs offering sold steady, the rest of the feeder offering sold \$2-6 higher. Slaughter cows sold \$1 lower and bulls steady; Demand good and supply light. Cows made up approximately 24 percent of the run, 76 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 44 percent of the offering, 51 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 26 percent.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, \$39-43.50, Low Dressing \$36.50; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$40-46.50, Low Dressing \$37.50; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, \$34.50-39, High Dressing \$42.50.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1520-2140 lbs, bulk \$52.50-56.25.

REPLACEMENT HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Pot Load, 980-1245 lbs 3rd stage, \$950-1270.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 4-7 yrs old, 870-1345 lbs 2nd and 3rd stage, \$670-800. 8 yrs to short and solid mouth, 820-1360 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$480-550.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 3-7 yrs old, 890-1420 lbs with 80-280 lbs calves, \$710-1060 per pair. Δ
