Compared to last week, steers and heifers under 500 lbs sold \$5 higher, the rest of the offering sold \$1-4 lower. Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$1 higher; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 34 percent of the run, 66 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 44 percent of the offering, 47 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 8 percent.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1430-2115 lbs \$58.25-63.50, High Dressing \$67.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: 4-7 yrs old, 820-1350 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$580-770.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 1-2: 890-1355 lbs, 4-7 yrs old, with 85-140 lbs calves, \$745-830 per pair.
