Receipts: 360; Last Week: 490; Year Ago: 654

Compared to last week, steers over 600 lbs sold \$2 lower, the rest of the offering sold \$3-6 higher on a limited test. Slaughter cows sold \$1 higher and bulls sold \$2 higher; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 20 percent of the run, 80 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 45 percent of the offering, 49 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaaled around 20 percent.

FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 350-400 lbs \$115-119; few 400-500 lbs \$100-110; 500-600 lbs \$95-102.50; few 600-700 lbs \$80-90. Medium 2: Few 300-350 lbs \$90-93; few 450-500 lbs \$90-95.50; few 500-600 lbs \$88-92.50; few 600-625 lbs \$75.25-82.50.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 300-400 lbs \$90-94; 400-450 lbs \$88-94; few 450-500 lbs \$82.75-91; 500-600 lbs \$80.50-87.50; few 850-875 lbs

\$70.25-75; pkg 1022 lbs \$62.50. Medium 2: Few 400-450 lbs \$80-83.25; few 550-600 lbs \$75-80.50.

FEEDER BULLS: Medium and Large 1-2: Pkg 468 lbs \$95.50; few 600-700 lbs \$75.25-85.25.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, few \$41.25-43.50, High Dressing few \$45-46; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$43.50-46.25, High Dressing few \$47.75-48.75, Low Dressing \$40.50; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, few \$36-37.50.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1545-2265 lbs, bulk \$54-56.25, High Dressing \$61.50.

STOCKER COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Scarce.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: 5-7 yrs old, 920-1340 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$650-800. 8 yrs to short and solid mouth, 880-1315 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$415-530.
