No Sale Next Week (Aug 2) Due To Heat

Receipts: 300; Last Week: 288; Year Ago: 388

Compared to last week, 300 lbs steers and heifers and the 500 lbs steers sold \$2-4 higher, the rest of the offering sold \$2-4 lower on a limit test. Slaughter cows sold \$3 lower, bulls not tested; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 24 percent of the run, 76 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 47 percent of the offering, 36 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 15 percent.

FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Pkg 285 lbs \$138; few 300-400 lbs \$134-140; few 400-450 lbs \$125-140; few 450-500 lbs \$120.50-131; 500-575 lbs \$126.50-135; pkg 760 lbs \$112.50; few 800-850 lbs \$112.50-115. Medium 2: Few 400-475 lbs \$110.50-116.50; pkg 810 lbs \$105.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 300-375 lbs \$125-135; 425-500 lbs \$122-128; 500-575 lbs \$118-122; pkg 610 lbs \$113. Medium 2: Pkg 395 lbs \$115.50; pkg 485 lbs \$110.50.

FEEDER BULLS: Medium and Large 1-2: Pkg 435 lbs \$120; pkg 555 lbs \$118. Medium 2: Few 500-575 lbs \$105-110; pkg 680 lbs \$93.50.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, few \$67.50-69, High Dressing \$72-72.75; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$67-71, High Dressing \$72-74, Low Dressing \$64.50; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, few \$58.75-60, High Dressing \$62, Low Dressing \$51.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1560-1960 lbs bulk \$80-81.75.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium 2: Few 4-6 yrs old, 850-1030 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$800-1000.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 4-7 yrs old with 90-180 lbs calves, \$920-1270 per pair. Δ
