Receipts: 443; Last Week: 370; Year Ago: 512

Compared to last week, 300-400 lbs steers sold \$5 higher, the rest of the offering sold uneven, \$2 higher to \$2 lower. Slaughter cows sold steady and bulls sold \$2 higher; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 13 percent of the run, 87 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 44 percent of the offering, 42 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 38 percent.

FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 300-400 lbs \$114-123; 400-500 lbs \$100-111; few 500-600 lbs \$94.50-102; few 600-625 lbs \$93.50-94.50; 700-800 lbs \$90-98. Medium 2: Few 350-400 lbs \$107-110; few 425-500 lbs \$92.50-99.50; few 500-550 lbs \$92-94.50.

FEEDER HOLSTEINS: Large 3: Few 400-450 lbs \$60-66.75; pkg 504 lbs \$62.50; pkg 600 lbs \$66.50.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Pkg 318 lbs \$110; few 350-400 lbs \$92-98; 400-500 lbs \$90-100; few

500-600 lbs \$84.25-91.75; few 600-675 lbs \$86-91; 725-750 lbs \$84.50-88; pkg 928 lbs \$90. Medium 2: Few 425-450 lbs \$76.50-82.50; few 450-500 lbs \$83.50-89.50; few 500-600 lbs \$80-86; 600-675 lbs \$75-86.50; pkg 870 lbs \$75.50.

FEEDER BULLS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 500-600 lbs \$85.50-95.50; few 650-700 lbs \$81-89.50. Medium 2: Few 600-675 lbs \$75.50-78.50.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, few \$43-48, High Dressing \$49.50; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$43.25-47, High Dressing \$50.75, Low Dressing \$40.50; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, few \$36-40.50.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: 1535-1975 lbs, bulk \$55.50-57.50, High Dressing \$59-60.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: 4-7 yrs old, 1080-1920 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage \$695-800. 8 yrs to short and solid mouth, 860-1370 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$430-630.
