

# Fruitland Livestock Market

**Receipts: 486; Last Week: 362; Year Ago: 437**

Compared to last week, 500-600 lbs heifers sold \$3 lower, the rest of the offering sold steady to \$3 higher on a limited test. Slaughter cows and bulls sold steady; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 28 percent of the run, 72 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 41 percent of the offering, 50 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 18 percent.

**FEEDER STEERS:** Medium and Large 1-2: Few 275-300 lbs \$135-137; few 300-350 lbs \$125-133; few 350-400 lbs \$132-140.50; 400-500 lbs \$130-143; fancy pkg 425 lbs \$148; 500-600 lbs \$120-129.50; few 600-675 lbs \$124.50-130; pkg 772 lbs \$122. Medium 2: 300-400 lbs \$110-126; few 400-500 lbs \$116-123; pkg 602 lbs \$119; pkg 772 lbs \$110.

**FEEDER HEIFERS:** Medium and Large 1-2: Few 250-275 lbs \$125.50-130; 300-400 lbs \$121-129.50; 400-500 lbs \$119-127.50; 500-600 lbs \$114-122; 625-700 lbs \$112-122; few 725-775 lbs \$108-110. Medium 2: Few 300-400

lbs \$115-120; pkg 425 lbs \$110; few 550-525 lbs \$115.50-118.50; pkg 605 lbs \$105.50; pkg 792 lbs \$105.

**FEEDER BULLS:** Medium and Large 1-2: 500-600 lbs \$112-125; few 600-625 lbs \$110-117.

**SLAUGHTER COWS:** Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, \$58.50-64.50, High Dressing \$66.50-71.50; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$58.50-65, High Dressing \$67-70.50, Low Dressing \$55.50; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, few \$48-53, High Dressing \$56.25-60.50, Low Dressing \$38-43.50.

**SLAUGHTER BULLS:** Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1150-1840 lbs bulk \$67.50-75, High Dressing \$76.50, Low Dressing \$64.50.

**STOCKER COWS:** Medium and Large 2: Scarce.

**REPLACEMENT COWS:** Medium and Large 1-2: Few 4-7 yrs, 930-1135 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage tested bred cows, \$780-870.

**COW-CALF PAIRS:** Medium and Large 1-2: Few 5-6 yrs old, 1030-1220 lbs with 110-210 lbs calves, \$975-1125 per pair. Δ
